

Zion Lutheran School Community Service Sheet



Who: As a student in Zion’s junior high program, you will perform a minimum of 9 hours of community service within this school year. Only 3 hours may be submitted as school-related volunteering. At least 6 hours of service must be done away from school.

What & When: This form is to be turned in to your Religion teacher by the end of May. We will practice filling out this form early in the school year, and you will find several opportunities to serve your community at school. You will be reminded dozens of times during the school year to turn this form in by the end of May. You may turn this form in any time before then, provided that you’ve completed your 9 hours.

Where & How: There are countless opportunities to serve. You might enjoy working at a food shelter, volunteering for chores at your church, mission trips to help the less fortunate, or volunteering to help with various school-related functions. You might start your own food or clothes drive, join a service organization, or volunteer at a Boys & Girls Club, Library, Red Cross Office, or even your church office. You should also ask your teachers about community service opportunities. You could do a web search for “Community Service Snohomish County” to find even more ideas. Usually, work you do for others without getting paid may count as community service. If you’re not sure that your service task will be counted as community service, ask your Religion teacher.

Why: Learning to serve God, and to put his desires above your own is an important part of your Faith. We worship God by doing what he wants us to do, by giving back some of the gifts that he pours out upon us, and by having an attitude of love in our lives rather than an attitude of self-indulgence. God expects us to put him first in our lives, put others second, and put our own needs and wants third. *“He said to him, “What is written in the Law? How do you read it?” And he answered, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.” And he said to him, “You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live.”* —Luke 10: 26-28
