AUTHOR

- Acts 15:1
- Refers to Genesis 17
- "Historically, Jews and Christians alike have held that Moses was the author/compiler of the first five books of the OT...The Bible itself suggests Mosaic authorship of Genesis..." CSSB 2

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READERS & RECIPIENTS

- "Compiled" by Moses as inspired by God
- A history of the world, written for anyone who had or has questions about it's origin.
- A history of God's relationship with man; a study of the nature of God, written for anyone interested.

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Major OT Themes found in this Book: 12

- 1. God is Love
- 2. God Creates
- 3. Israel (we) are supposed to be God's Obedient Servants

- 5. God is Angry with His People for Rejecting Him
- 6. God Forgives and Blesses those who Follow Him
- 7. Israel (we) are God's Chosen Examples
- 8. God Speaks through His Prophets
- 9. God is Always with His People
- 10. God is Just and Merciful
- 11. God Keeps His Promises
- 12. Israel (we) are Redeemed and Restored by the Blood of Christ
